



Dear Patients of Henderson Mill Dental Care,

Please know that Henderson Mill Dental Care is closely monitoring the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak via the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH). The virus and protocols around it are changing quickly, and we are working to make sure we stay up to date on any helpful information which is disseminated by the CDC.

We ask all patients and their guests who have a fever, symptoms of a respiratory infection, or have been exposed to a person with a coronavirus, the flu or any other communicable disease to reschedule their appointments. We will be asking screening questions, posting signs in our offices, and following CDC and Georgia DPH recommendations for screening and management of patients. If you are at all concerned you may have a serious infectious disease, your best course of action is to seek care at your primary care physician's office or local hospital's emergency department.

Health officials know COVID-19 is transmitted through close contact with an infected individual. Key measures to help prevent further spread of COVID-19 include: practicing good hand hygiene (hand washing, hand sanitizer use of 60% alcohol or more), avoiding touching the face with unwashed hands, avoiding close contact with sick individuals and staying away from other individuals while sick. If you have not yet received a flu shot, we encourage you to consider following this recommendation from the CDC.
